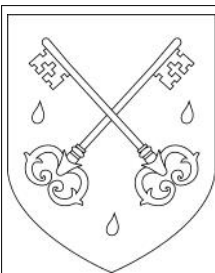

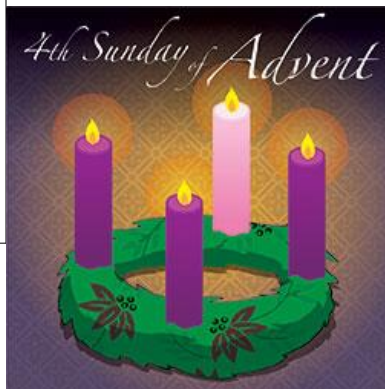

The Vigil of Christmas!

This year the Vigil of Christmas falls on the Forth Sunday of Advent making this day a great day of preparation! On this day and night in which we anticipate the coming of Our Savior,

do we really realize the importance of the moment re-presented before us in the liturgy? Tomorrow we will celebrate the birth of someone by whom we actually mark time. 2023 “AD”, which is the Latin abbreviation for “Anno Domini”, “in the Year of the Lord”. This Jesus is so great that we even count time by His birth. It is very fitting that we do this, for our life would be fruitless without Him. For if He did not come we could not fulfill the very purpose of our existence: “to know, to love and to serve God in this life so that we could be happy with Him forever in the next” (Catechism answer #1) It is only through His birth that we have hope to fulfill our true end—to be with God!
