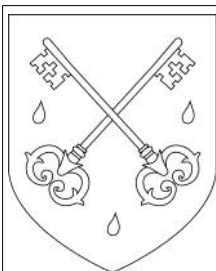

Let us recall that the birth of our Savior is such a great feast that it cannot be limited to only one day. Holy Mother Church celebrates with an octave—eight days of celebration—that allows the faithful to more deeply contemplate the mystery of the Nativity so that we may better apply it to our lives. “and the Word was made flesh and dwelt among us!” This is the greatest human birth ever -for it was the birth of God Himself, the Second Person of the Holy Trinity, according to His human nature.
