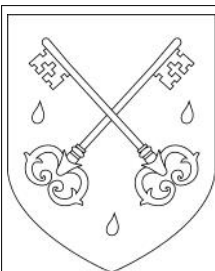

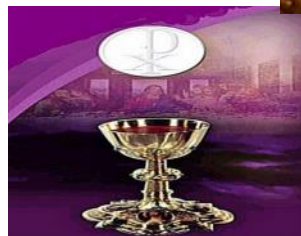
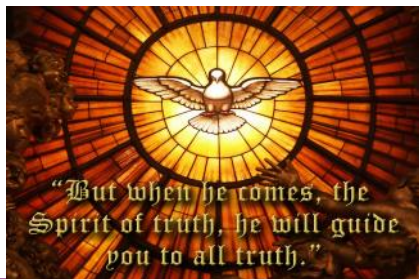

SUNDAY AFTER THE ASCENSION



The nine days from Ascension Thursday to Pentecost Sunday is depicted as the first Novena of the Church called by Jesus Himself as we read on Ascension Thursday "and while eating with

them He charged them not to depart from Jerusalem but to wait for the promise of the Father of which you have heard by my mouth, for John indeed baptized with water but you shall be baptized by the Holy Spirit not many days hence." The apostles did as Our Lord asked and perhaps having learned an important lesson from their big mistake at the Garden of Gethsemane PRAYED CONSTANTLY those nine days in the Upper Room. "All those with one mind continued in prayer with the women and Mary, the Mother of Jesus" (Acts 1:14) In today's Gospel we hear Jesus promise again to send the Holy Spirit: "But when the advocate has come whom I will send you from the Father, the Spirit of truth who proceeds from the Father He will bear witness concerning Me. And you will bear witness because from the beginning you are with Me" LET US ENTER INTO THAT UPPER ROOM AND JOIN THE APOSTLES AND THE CHURCH JESUS CHRIST HIMSELF ESTABLISHED AND PRAY FOR THE COMING OF THE HOLY SPIRIT, THE-SANCTIFIER, WHO WILL TEACH US THE TRUTH SO WE WILL WITNESS TO JESUS CHRIST OUR REDEEMER!
VENI SANCTE SPIRITUS! COME HOLY SPIRIT!
