The Good Samaritan

In today's Gospel Jesus tells the disciples "Blessed are the eyes that see what you see! For I say to you many prophets and kings have desired to see what you see and they have not seen it and to hear what you hear and have not heard it." Could you imagine living at the time of Christ, hearing His words and being next to Him? Seeing Him lovingly smile at YOU? Today we hear His words transcending time and space - right here at Holy Family Church, Dayton Ohio 2024 Do we take to heart those words? Do we see Him hidden in the Holy Eucharist? Do we experience Him truly present in the Blessed Sacrament!

How blessed we truly are!

"What must I do to obtain eternal life?" This is the question asked by the lawyer in today's gospel. In our secular world many deny the reality of eternal life and the fact that there is indeed an Almighty, Creator God. What are they living for? Let us recall our first catechism lesson: "What is the purpose of man's existence?" The answer of course is: "The purpose for our existence is to know, love and serve God in this life so we can be happy with Him forever in the next!" How sad that so many people do not know this fundamental answer or question!! What is their purpose? Our Lord answers the lawyer's question with a question "What is written in the Law?" "Thou shalt love the Lord thy God with thy whole heart, with thy whole soul, with thy whole strength and with thy whole mind and thou shalt love thy neighbor as thyself" responded the lawyer. To which Jesus affirmed "Do this and thou shalt live." Once we truly know God we will love and serve Him but we must also see Him in our neighbor which can be very difficult! Our Lord gives us the Parable of the Good Samaritan to help us realize that WE were once in the ditch! He saved US! How important to follow His admonition "Go and do thou also in like manner!" AND ANSWERING : WHO IS MY NEIGHBOR?!??

Feast of the Assumption



Thursday, August 15th, is the Feast of the Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary body and soul into heaven!
