## Thirteenth Sunday After Pentecost

Today's gospel is the healing of the ten lepers. The Church's purpose in selecting this true event is two fold. We marvel at the infinite mercy of God who has compassion on all men regardless of race or creed. Samaritans were despised by the Jews. Yet Jesus heals him. How great He is and how much He loves us! Yet we also see in this event the depths of ingratitude we as human beings can sink. This story is not an isolated incident in the Gospels. Most of those who were miraculously cured by Jesus forgot to thank Him. However, in today's Gospel there was at least one man who came back with an attitude of gratitude.
