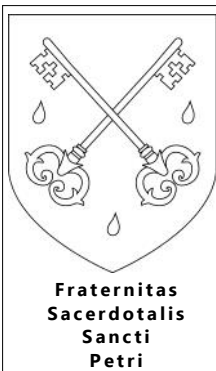

RESUMED FOURTH SUNDAY AFTER EPIPHANY

WHAT? The 4th Sunday after Epiphany in November? Believe it or not there is method to the madness! Due to the fact that Easter is a movable feast (ie not on a specific date like Christmas, Dec25th) the number of Sundays after Epiphany to Septuagesima Sunday and the number of Sundays after Pentecost to Advent are variable depending on when Easter falls each year. If Easter is early there are less Sundays after Epiphany so these Sundays are added between the 23rd Sunday after Pentecost and the 24th (and Last) Sunday after Pentecost. Therefore the Fourth Sunday After Epiphany which was not offered before Septuagesima began, will be offered today. For the Resumed Sundays the Introit, Gradual, Offertory and Communion are taken from the 23rd Sunday after Pentecost but the Collect, Epistle, Gospel and Postcommunion are from the Fourth Sun. After Epiphany. The 24th Sun. After Pentecost is always the last Sunday before Advent due to the nature of its epistle and Gospel regarding the end of time which is indeed suitable for the last Sunday of the Liturgical Year. So yes indeed today's Mass is the Fourth Sunday After Epiphany Resumed! Got it?! Good!

November Plenary Indulgence for the Poor Souls



According to the Handbook of Indulgences a plenary indulgence—the remission of all temporal punishment due to sins already confessed—can be gained for a Poor Soul in Purgatory each day from Nov. 1st through Nov. 8th inclusive by simply visiting a cemetery and praying, even only mentally, for a departed soul under the usual conditions of Confession, Holy Communion, prayers for the intentions of the Pope and detachment from all sin. Let's be sure to take advantage of this great mercy and act of charity for the Poor Souls!! We may need it someday! Eternal rest grant unto them!
