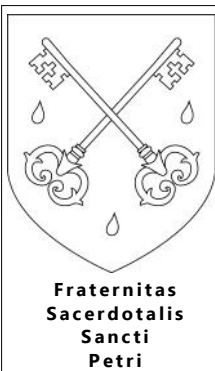

THE THIRD SUNDAY AFTER EPIPHANY

Today the Introit, gradual, offertory and Communion of the Mass all testify to Our Lord's Divine nature. In the Extraordinary Form we continue to rejoice that Our Messiah has come! We prepared for Him during all of Advent We now continue to celebrate His birth. He did not come some 2024 years ago and then POP like a bubble and everything went back to "business as usual" as if He had not come. Mary and Joseph did not just leave His memory at Bethlehem that first Christmas but after their sojourn into Egypt to protect His life (yes even the leaders back then thought they could say what children live or die in the most horrible ways) they took Him home to Nazareth where He grew before their eyes each day loving Him more and more. They certainly did not forget about or take for granted this amazing gift from Almighty God.

Do we realize that gift of Our Lord being born again for us this Christmas? Is the Christ Child growing in our hearts? If we only knew the Gift we have! In today's epistle St. Paul exhorts us: "do not be overcome with evil but overcome evil with good!" How timely his words are for us as a nation commemorating last Wednesday, January 22nd, the 52nd anniversary of the Roe v Wade decision. A day that will live in infamy, the day the US "SUPREME" Court overruled Almighty God and the Fifth Commandment by legalizing abortion. For half a century the American people have been desensitized with the indiscriminate killing of the unborn. Since then more American babies have been killed than the estimated total deaths from World War II—over 63 MILLION! And yes, even after Dodds V Jackson which overturned Roe V Wade, the killing of the innocent and maiming of women continues in our land and here in the Miami Valley, now 80 a week under the guise of "planned Parenthood"! No wonder life is cheap everywhere! The Killing must stop!

Last Wednesday marked the 52nd Anniversary of Roe V Wade. Since then an estimated 63 million babies have been destroyed in their mother's womb. We pray for these little ones who were denied their
