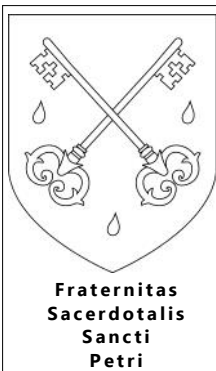

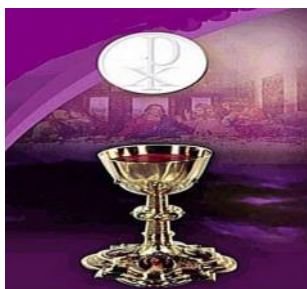

Septuagesima Sunday

According to the liturgical calendar for the Extraordinary Form today is Septuagesima Sunday. The Season of Septuagesima is the two and a half weeks leading to Ash Wednesday (March 5th this year!) which is the beginning of Lent, also known as “Quadragesima”. Today we see the liturgical emphasis dims as the joys of Christmas and Epiphany are now giving way to the realization of WHY He came to earth and the heavy price the Christ Child will have to pay in order to redeem us. We remember the words of Holy Simeon from Feb 2nd, Feast of the Purification: “Behold this child is destined for the fall and for the rise of many in Israel and for a sign that shall be contradicted. And thy own soul a sword shall pierce that the thoughts of many hearts may be revealed”. The Season of Septuagesima is therefore a preparation for Lent. It serves as a time of transition, a liturgical “buffer”, by which the Christian soul may pass from Christmas joys to the stern penance of the sacred forty days. Liturgically we see the white vestments of Christmas and Epiphany, symbols of joy, change into the penitential color of violet. We also notice the absence of the “Gloria” on Sundays and feria days of the season as well as the total suppression of the “Alleluia” throughout the season until it is sung again three times at the Easter Vigil demonstrating the great joy of the Resurrection of Our Lord & His victory over sin and death! But first we will do penance following Christ from the desert the first Sunday of Lent to the cross on Good Friday. Thus this liturgical Season of Septuagesima invites us to begin thinking about what we are going to give up (food, drink, games, bad habits, TV & internet etc.) and what we are going to do positively (adoration, prayers, alms, works of mercy, spiritual reading, virtues, etc.) during this coming Lent for the love of Our Dear Lord who came into the world that first Christmas with the sole purpose to suffer and die for love of us! Pray to the Holy Spirit, the Sanctifier for inspiration as we begin to prepare for Lent 2025!!

What Is the Jubilee Year 2025?

A Jubilee Year is a special time in the Church's tradition encouraging holiness through acts of reconciliation and communion with our brothers and sisters. The Church celebrates an Ordinary Jubilee every twenty-five years, with the last celebration having taken place in 2000. Jubilee Year 2025 will be marked by special opportunities for grace through the Sacrament of Penance, local pilgrimages and the Jubilee Indulgence. Seeking forgiveness and growing in repentance are special fruits to gain during a Jubilee Year.

Pilgrimage Sites In The Archdiocese

Here in the Archdiocese of Cincinnati, three locations have been designated as Jubilee Pilgrimage Sites: the Cathedral Basilica of Saint Peter in Chains, the Shrine of the Holy Relics at Maria Stein, and Emmanuel Catholic Church in Dayton. A pilgrimage visit to any of these sites can gain a plenary Indulgence under the usual conditions during this jubilee year!

Catholic Ministries Appeal

This weekend is the CMA Commitment weekend for 2025.
