

HOLY TRINITY SUNDAY!



Today we celebrate the Feast of the Holy Trinity which expresses the dogma that in the One God there are Three Divine Persons. Although we know of no other being that is three persons in one nature and although we cannot fully comprehend the Holy Trinity, this is a mystery we are able to believe without error because Almighty God, who created all that is out of nothing and cannot lie, has indeed revealed it to us. St. Thomas Aguinas explains this Mystery in the Summa Theologica, Ia, 97-43. He also shows us it is reasonable to believe that the Great Creator God is far beyond what we as creatures can know or understand. St Patrick used the shamrock to illustrate the concept of three in one in that the shamrock has three leaves but constitutes one living being. However, unlike the clover that has three leaves those leaves can be taken apart but in God there are no parts. The Three Persons are interior to the one nature of God yet have a distinct relationship within that One Nature. May we one day enjoy and contemplate the beatific vision for all eternity in heaven! Praise the Holy Trinity, the undivided Unity!
