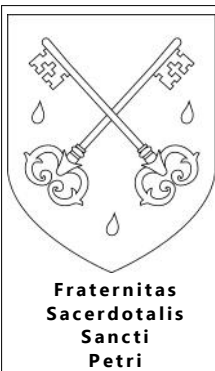

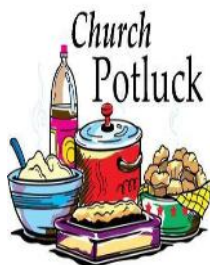

THIRD SUNDAY AFTER EASTER
