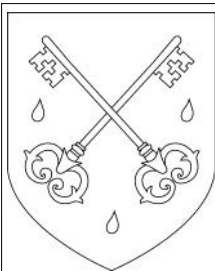

EIGHTH SUNDAY AFTER PENTECOST

*Today's Gospel is the Parable of the Unjust Steward. Our Lord recalls to our mind that there will indeed be a day of reckoning. Are we prepared for that day? If we take the scripture literally we could think Jesus is actually telling us it is okay to break the 7th and 8th commandments. But taken in context of all the scriptures we see that this is indeed NOT the case. In the parable the master commends the steward NOT for his lying and stealing but for his cunning and his foresight to prepare for the future! We are stewards of God's gifts. He has given us body, soul and intellect to use according to His intentions. We can squander these gifts or use them for His greater glory but we too shall have a day of reckoning. And it is nearer than we think! We will be called to render an account of our stewardship of God's gifts. Have we used them wisely as true children of God who know the true purpose of life—to know, to love, to serve God in this life so we can be happy with Him forever in the next? While we still have time we **MUST** put our accounts in order. We can erase all our past mistakes and dishonest acts with a true, sincere confession, penances, reception of the sacraments, the Corporal & Spiritual Works of Mercy, giving alms and gaining the indulgences that Holy Mother Church grants to us her dear children. We can prepare ourselves for that day by surrendering our earthly freedom to God, by living as His children so that we will be able to stand before Him, the Just Judge, when the time comes as it surely will! How sweet it would be to hear those words "well done good and faithful servant, enter into the joy of your Master!" The Good Thief, a thief and a murderer, just before his death was able to take advantage of Christ's presence next to Him & while everyone else was mocking and spitting on Him St. Dismus declares Jesus King! And in reward he hears those most wonderful words in all the scriptures : "THIS DAY YOU SHALL BE WITH ME IN PARADISE!" Let us take advantage of the presence of Jesus today! **PREPARE FOR THE ACCOUNTING!***

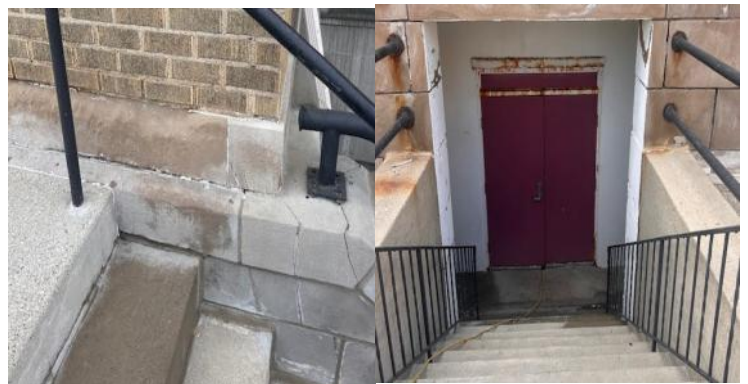

PROJECT UPDATES!

As you have probably noticed the tuckpointing project of the East side of the church has progressed and the majority of the work completed filling the cracks between the bricks and stones with mortar. In previous years they had simply been filled with caulk which has now indeed deteriorated, allowing water to penetrate and cause damage as was evidenced by pools of water in the basement by the east windows. Most of the tuckpointing has been completed. However, as you have also probably noticed that although the railing has white primer the black paint has not been completely applied due to the high temperatures. New stones have also been ordered to replace the cracked ones. The railing has been mostly primed but due to the hot weather the finished paint cannot be applied professionally according to the paint manufacturer. Meyer Restoration has also come up with a plan to restore and improve traction to the ramp leading into the Church with a slip resistant TUFFCOAT that should make the ramp more navigable especially for wheelchairs! Both the Pastoral Council and the Finance Committee have unanimously approved the ramp repair and improvement project. The concrete repairs and TUFFCOAT also require lower temperatures for best results so please be patient.



Here are some pics of what it looked like before the work. We will compare with new pics once the work is completed.

PARKING LOT EXTENTION We now have the City of Dayton permits to begin putting in a new parking lot extension in the vacant lot next to the rectory. This should help to alleviate the parking problem for our growing parish especially during the winter months! We will be meeting with our landscape engineer and Houser Asphalt to get the ground work started!
