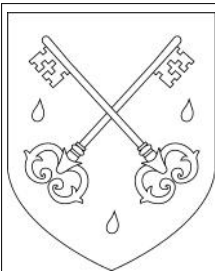

Ninth Sunday After Pentecost



In today's gospel we read the account of Our Lord weeping over Jerusalem. "If thou had known, in this thy day, the things that are for thy peace! For days will come upon thee when thy enemies will throw up a rampart about thee and surround and shut thee in on every side and will dash thee to the ground and thy children within

thee and will not leave in thee one stone upon another because thou has not known the time of thy visitation." Our Lord was crying over Jerusalem for being God he knew that of their own free will the high priest and the Sanhedrin, the leaders of what had been "God's Chosen People," were going to reject their own Savior, the one God had sent them to be the Messiah. Because of their rejection they would be destroyed. Jesus' prophesy did come true. Some 40 years later, 70 AD, Titus, the Roman General took Jerusalem, that once Holy City, and after a long siege which caused death by starvation of many hundred thousands of its inhabitants, leveled it to the ground. Thousands of survivors were sold as slaves. The famous Jewish historian, Josephus, wrote: "The whole circuit of the city was so thoroughly leveled and dug up that no one visiting it would believe that it had once been inhabited." This was the price of disobedience & rejecting God. This was the price of saying we will do what we want. We will be our own gods. By our pride of wanting to have things our own way we too reject God and lose His protection falling into the hands of the enemy by default. Pray for our country and for ourselves that we do not become like that Jerusalem! (The above image is "and Jesus wept" in OK City where the Murrah building was blown up on April 19 1995 killing 168 including 19 children) God have Mercy on us!

FIRST SATURDAY THIS WEEK!

This devotion is actually apart of the Our Lady of Fatima message fully approved by the Church. During the July apparition, in which she showed the children a vision of hell, Mary also showed them her Immaculate Heart surrounded by thorns. She told them that she would come to ask for the Communions of Reparation on First Saturdays for the conversion of sinners and to achieve peace in the world. This was fulfilled when she appeared with the Christ Child to Sr. Lucia who was then a Dorothean Nun at the convent of Pontevedre, Spain. She said: ***"To all those who on five consecutive First Saturdays will 1) go to confession (within 8 days before or after) 2) receive Holy Communion; 3) pray 5 decades of the rosary and 4) keep me company for 15 minutes while meditating on the mysteries of the rosary in reparation for the blasphemies against my Immaculate Heart, I PROMISE to assist them with all the graces necessary for their salvation at the hour of their death"***
