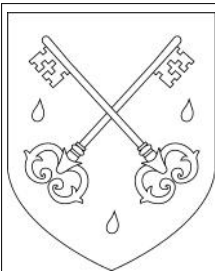

TWELTH SUNDAY AFTER PENTECOST

The Good Samaritan



In today's Gospel Jesus tells the disciples "Blessed are the eyes that see what you see! For I say to you many prophets and kings have desired to see what you see and they have not

seen it & to hear what you hear and

have not heard it." Could you imagine living at the time of Christ, hearing His words & being next to Him? Seeing

Him lovingly smile at YOU? Today we hear His words transcending time and space - right here at Holy Family Church, Dayton Ohio. Do we take to heart those words?

Do we see Him hidden in the Holy Eucharist? Do we experience Him truly present in the Blessed Sacrament? How

blessed we truly are!

"What must I do to obtain eternal life?" This is the question asked by the lawyer in today's gospel. In our secular world many deny the reality of eternal life and the fact that there is indeed an Almighty, Creator God. What are they living for? Let us recall our first catechism lesson:

"What is the purpose of man's existence?" The answer of course is : "The purpose for our existence is to know, love and serve God in this life so we can be happy with Him forever in the next!" How sad that so many people do not know this fundamental answer. What is their purpose?

Our Lord answers the lawyer's question with a question

"What is written in the Law?" "Thou shall love the Lord thy God with thy whole heart, with thy whole soul, with thy whole strength & with thy whole mind & thou shall love thy neighbor as thyself" responded the lawyer. To which Jesus affirmed "Do this and thou shall live." Once we truly

know God we will love & serve Him but we must also see Him in our neighbor which can be very difficult! Our Lord gives us the Parable of the Good Samaritan to help us realize that WE were once in the ditch! He saved US! How important to follow His admonition "Go & do thou also in like manner" answering that important question :

Who is my Neighbor?
