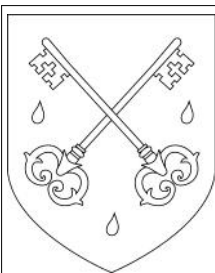

The Eighteenth Sunday After Pentecost

In the Gospel today (Mt 9:1-8) we see again, as we did last week, another proof that yes indeed Jesus, Our Redeemer was and still is God. In healing the paralytic who was lowered down from the roof by his friends, Jesus first says to him "take courage son thy sins are forgiven thee". And of course the scribes right away said within themselves "this man blasphemes who can forgive sins but God?" Jesus knew he would stir them up but he does it to teach then, as he did in last week's Gospel, who He truly is—He is God! All dogmas flow from this truth and anyone seeing this truth has no logical choice but to accept and follow the one true Catholic Church that He Himself founded and actually delegated the power to forgive sins to its priests on the very day of His resurrection from the dead (see JN 20:23). It is also the Catholic Church who received His promises "the gates of hell shall not prevail against it" (MT 16:19) and "Know that I am with you until the consummation of the world" (MT 28:20) In today's Gospel it is the faith of the friends of the sick man that brought Jesus to heal him, first of his sins then of his paralysis. Let us pray that our faith in Jesus continues to grow!

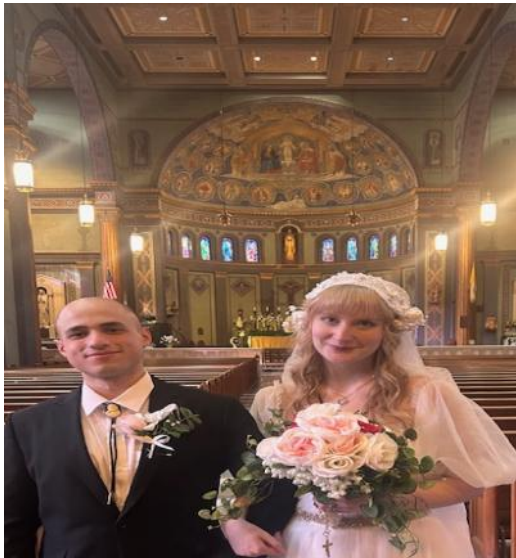
WELCOME NEWEST MEMBER

PRO LIFE EVENTS!

Sept & Oct are the busiest times of year for Pro-life events. Here's a quick list of what's going on.

(1) Sunday, September 20 — 40 Days for Life —

The 40 Days for Life Fall campaign begins on September 20th and ends on November 1, 2026. Our goal, as a parish, is to volunteer 40 hours of prayer during the campaign. Parishioners should sign up to pray on the 40 Days for Life website but also sign up on the sign up sheets at the church entrances so we can track how many hours of prayer we provide. **The campaign is 7 am to 7 pm daily at the Planned Parenthood at 1401 E. Stroop Rd. but the most important hours are when the "clinic" is open 9-5 M-F and on the 3rd Saturday of the month.** If you absolutely can't volunteer any hours at the "clinic" please consider praying a rosary for the end to abortion, this can also be noted on our sign up sheets. The prayer warriors who are there every-day have let me know that Friday mornings 10-12 are a time of particular need.

(2) Friday, October 2 — Ohio March for Life at State Capitol in Columbus. THIS FRIDAY!

A bus is being organized by St. Luke's this year to the Statehouse. Go to [March for Life.org/ohio](http://MarchforLife.org/ohio) for more information. Pre -Rally Concert begins at 10AM at the State House lawn. The Rally will begin around 11Am with the March at noon.

(3) Sunday, October 4 — Life Chain Holy Family always has a big turnout for this event where we take our pro-Life faith to the streets of Dayton (along Stroop Road) in peaceful, silent prayer while holding a sign with the truth that states: "Abortion Kills Children" that could save a child & Mother! Women have actually told us that they were thinking of having an abortion but changed their mind after seeing so many people holding their signs and praying! Be sure to mark your Calendars and get there early @1:45 so you will have your sign and begin praying by 2PM!
